In the last days the house of the Lord is to be established in the top (ROCK) of the mountains.

*Job 39:28 She **dwelleth and abideth on the rock**, upon the crag of the rock, and the **strong place**.*

*Job 39:29 From thence she **seeketh the prey**, and her **eyes behold afar off**.*

### WILDERNESS ROCKS ARE EAGLE NESTING PLACES

-HIGH, ...CRAGGY, ...STRONG

-IF POSSIBLE : BORN ON OR NEAR A ROCK

-ROCK BECOMES HIS /HER ROCK FOR LIFE (USUALLY NEAR BIRTH PLACE)

-WILL NOT CHANGE ROCKS / ....HIS ROCK

### AN EAGLES' ROCK BECOMES .....

-THEIR PLACE TO MAINTAIN BEAUTY & APPEARANCE  
(dressing room Powder Room)

-REST & OBSERVATION

-ROCK MAINTENANCE

BEAK : grind off calcium beak deposits

FEET : break off nubbs from feet

TALONS : clean & sharpen their beak & talons

FEATHERS : Shake out loose feathers

DEATH : Strong & Healthy Eagles will die on their ROCK

: Have been seen with a pleasant far away look

:Simply cross their wings and lean back and die

-UNHEALTHY EAGLES DIE LONGING FOR THEIR ROCK

### THOUGHTS on the NATURE of EAGLES

Eagles never flock as vultures do. They will choose the tallest trees or the upmost rocky crags of the mountain. Eagles live in pairs in solitude.

Their powerful wings enable them to carry with their feet. Vultures don't carry as a rule. They feast and regurgitate.

The scripture refers to the eagle for:

**its swiftness in flight** (Deut 28:49),

**its mounting up** high in the sky (Job 39:27),

**its strength** (Psa 103:5),

**nesting in high places** (Jer 49:16), and

**its extraordinary vision** (Job 39:27-30).

... **our strength is renewed** as eagles Psa 103:5

## EAGLE'S MOPING PERIOD

- The eagle gets down in the dirt
- A graveyard of 27 eagles found in the N.C. wilderness  
They died looking up at their rock They died longing for their rock
- 1 eagle recent from the moping period cleaning himself on his ROCK  
Wet eyes, as though tears, screeched And Flew!

Eagles have been observed to experience a Mid-Life Crisis. Losing their desire to fly. For some reason they become grounded too long and lose their ability to mount up again. Their feet swell and burst open. Their beak becomes encrusted with calcium deposits.

This time has been called a Moping Period eagles have been witnessed to hobble around like chickens. They become so weak and listless with drooping heads they have even been picked up without fear.

In North Carolina wilderness, 8 eagles were grounded, unable to fly, and other eagles were witnessed to fly over dropping meat, circling and screeching to those on the ground. Several of the 8 crawled over to the meat, while several did not. The weak got weaker and died. The stronger ate and got stronger.

It has been observed among eagles that during the middle years of its life many seem to experience a time of depression. Rather than flying, they just walk around on the ground, weak. It time they will regain their strength and become beautiful again.

One eagle who had recently been observed to have been a moping period, had flown again to the top of its mountain rock. Its eyes were wet with what seemed as tears. He walked to the edge of his rock and screamed. They flew away in search of meat for the eagle brothers still down on the ground. He will not land again. He will fly over with a fist full of meat to drop. But he won't land.

## SEVERAL EAGLE EXPERIENCES

**Several eagles were found huddled** on the ground in the mountains of North Carolina in the midst of the woods. They were sickly, feathers missing, beaks crusted over, feet swollen, and drooping heads as a chicken with a rung neck.

**Some Eagles had stayed on the ground** too long and had lost their will and ability to fly to the rocky cliffs and tall trees above. At particular times several other flying eagles were witnessed flying over these sick eagles dropping chunks of meat. Some of the sick eagles crawled over to the fresh squirrel and rabbit to eat. In time, these eagles who ate of these meat gifts became strong enough to again fly and soared to the top of the mountain. Those sick eagles which did not crawl over to the meat became weaker and later died.

**An eagle was noticed one day at a zoo.** It was a new arrival, unacquainted with zoos and their cages. The caged eagle had always been free and did not understand the cages bars.

Repeatedly the eagle flew into the bars of the cage. Over and over the eagle would fly head-long into the bars seemingly trying to fly or escape. It would sit on the floor waiting to regain its strength and try again. The eagle became more bewildered as his wings spread out with head-feathers fluttering to the floor of the cage.

- out away from the hustle and bustle of city life
- out away from the crowd
- out away from the World, Sodom
- they are "Abrahams", ... rather than "Lots"

**GOD'S CHRIST/(ENDTIME?) EAGLES :**

The woman (church) was given two wings of a Great Eagle. She is give a swiftness and ability to fly above the earth and go to HER PLACE which God has prepared for her in the wilderness to nourish and sustain her. Rev 12 (Where the Lion, Calf, and Man can not go.)
